Clean water	NAREP will work with stakeholders to provide water pumps in every community
Sanitation	NAREP will work with the community to ensure access to clean toilets for every community to improve health and prevent waterborne infections
Access to quality health care	NAREP will work with the community to provide an adequately staffed and equipped health centre in every established village community centre
Access to school	NAREP will work with the community to provide access to computer based learning for every child in a government school or adopted community school
Decent roads	NAREP will work with the community to provide well maintained all weather unpaved feeder roads and re-introduce food for work programmes
